The team at GRETB regrouped in the middle of September at Galway Technical Institute to discuss the upcoming TM5 in Ireland and next steps.



We have a lovely few days planned for our delegates arriving for the Ireland

visit in November. We are really looking forward to it. Work has commenced on our second video where we are focusing on the area of pastoral care. We are currently inputting our recent leaving cert results in August into the grade predictor tool and are also training staff to conduct the implementation of the tool with a further 250 transition year students. Work is underway on the intervention guide and strategy paper for dissemination to our fellow partners.
