

The School Improvement Partnership Project Evaluation Update April 2020

Recent Evaluation Completed

A comprehensive report on The Grade Predictor Tool trial has been completed and circulated to partners. The trial was far reaching in terms of institutions and courses and there is some evidence to suggest that impacts have been made. There are a number of recommendations for partners to consider.

We now need to add some placebo data to the report for students who did not undertake participation in the trial.

Current Ongoing Evaluation

- Grade Predictor Trial- partners are asked to collect some information for a group of students who did not participate in the trial. This is known as the placebo group. The targets for each partner to record this data on the spreadsheet are:

Xabec 17, GRETB 62, Sataedu 26, Zlinsky kraj 40.

The information is required by the end of May. Instructions have been issued separately.

- The User Manual survey is ongoing. Returns have been made from two partners and once the rest are completed an evaluation will take place of the User Manual produced by partners. Partners are asked to return surveys as soon as is feasible in order to complete this aspect of our work.
- Partners are reminded that they should continue to populate their spreadsheets for the implementation of the tool in their institutions. This is important.

Future Evaluation

- An evaluation will take place of The SIPP Intervention Guide. The evaluator will undertake this when the Guide is completed.
- A survey of partners needs to take place in relation to curriculum developments. This was planned as a focus group in Valencia. Another method for this will be devised.
- Any future activities such as a TPM or Multiplier event will need to be evaluated using the type of approach that has occurred throughout the project.
